**CRITERIA FOR INCLUSION ON JUDGES LIST**

**A1 LIST**

For people who have previously been approved by the Kennel Club to award CCs in the breed, have completed their first appointment and have support of the SEPMDC.

**A2 LIST**

For people who fulfil all the requirements for the A3 list, who have been assessed in accordance with the Kennel Club requirements and accepted by the Kennel Club for inclusion on the A2 list, and have the support of the SEPMDC.

**A3 LIST**

**For a Breed Specialist:**

a)

1. To have attended and passed the 3 KC Seminars:  
Points of a dog  
Requirements of a Show Judge  
Confirmation and Movement
2. To have stewarded 10 times as required by the KC.
3. To have owned the required number of dogs, 3, with Stud Book entries by the KC.
4. To provide a critique (under normal circumstance) that demonstrates an understanding of the Breed Standard.

b)

1. To have judged the Breed over a period of not less than seven years.
2. To have judged at least 80 dogs of the Breed and at least 20 classes.
3. To have been observed judging by a member of the Committee and having received a satisfactory report.
4. To provide a critique (under normal circumstances) that demonstrates an understanding of the Breed Standard.

Preference may be given to those candidates who have judged at a Breed Club Show.

**Non Breed Specialists:**

For those awarding CCs in two or more breeds in the Working and/or Pastoral Groups.

1. To have attended the Breed Specific Seminars as required by the KC.
2. To have a minimum of seven years judging experience in any one breed (to include five years in this breed) and to have the support of the SEPMDC.
3. To have judged at least 80 dogs of the Breed.
4. To have judged a minimum of 15 classes of the Breed.
5. To have awarded CCs in at least one other breed.
6. To have been observed judging by a member of the Committee and having received a satisfactory report.
7. To provide a critique (under normal circumstances) that demonstrates an understanding of the Breed Standard.

## **B LIST**

1. To have judged the Breed at least twice at Open Show level.
2. To have judged at least 10 classes in this Breed.
3. To have judged 25 dogs of the Breed.
4. To have attended and passed the 3 KC Seminars:  
Points of a dog  
Requirements of a Show Judge  
Confirmation and Movement
5. To have attended at least one Breed Specific Judging Seminar run in accordance with the relevant KC Code of Best Practice and passed an examination and/or assessment, where applicable.
6. To provide a critique (under normal circumstances) that demonstrates an understanding of the Breed Standard.

## **C LIST**

### **Either/Or**

1. To have attended and passed the SEPMDC or PMDC of GB Judges Course.
2. To have shown a sustained interest in the Breed.

### **Roll of Honour**

#### Minimum Criteria for Judges

1. To have previously been included in the A1 List of Approved Judges.
2. To have elected not to accept further appointments.
