Rules and Risk assessment for SEPMDC Championship Show 2021.

The Show will be held in conjunction with Southern Counties Canine Association and the SCCA have produced a full risk assessment which all exhibitors at this Show must follow and adhere to. Check SCCA website , EXHIBITORS INFORMATION for further details.

If anyone in your household has Covid 19 related symptoms, has tested positive, or have been contacted by NHS track and trace and advised to isolate, they must not attend the Show and should self-isolate as advised by Government Guidelines.

All persons attending this Show must follow the latest government guidance.

The following are additions to the above risk assessment with rules that apply to our show.

1. Exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by all Rules and Regulations on the entry form and must complete a Track and Trace form or scan the NHS QR code on the site. The Track and Trace form must be completed by **everyone** and placed in the box provided on the Secretary's table.
2. This show is unbenched.

3. Gazebos/Tents are allowed at this show in the designated areas, but must be no larger than 3mx 3m, and a safe distance apart. No tents etc. must be at the ringside. Chairs will not be provided so please bring your own for your own personal use only. (Although SCCA have since stated that a few chairs may be available.) If you use one it will be your responsibility to sanitize before use. Wipes will be available on one of the tables.
4. Judging will be outside, with gazebos type covering over rings. We will be in the same ring as SCCA PMD classes. There will be one other breed in before our Show. (1 dog entered)
5. Ring Numbers and ordered catalogues will be put into sealed bags with names on and on the table for you to collect. Only collect your own, please do not handle anyone else's bag.
6. Judges, Stewards and Exhibitors must always wear masks in the ring and maintain Social Distancing. Do not shake hands with the judge.
7. Spectators should not stand or sit ringside so as not to come into contact with exhibitors in the ring.
8. The ring will have an entry and exit, please use these correctly, and sanitize hands before entry.
9. The Judge will decide on the day what procedures for actual showing will be used.
10. The Judge must sanitize their hands at the start of each class and after assessing each dog Additional assessments must be kept to a minimum.
11. The handler will show the dog's teeth to the Judge.
12. The Stewards will sanitize their hands before handing out Prize cards and rosettes which will be individually placed in clear bags , for your safety.
13. Equipment must not be shared between the Judge and the Stewards. Separate tables will be supplied. The Judge will complete the Judging book and remove the result sheets, putting them in a folder/box for the Secretary to collect at the end of the show.
14. In accordance to K.C Guide lines Award boards will not be used to avoid crowding.

15. Any cages used at the show must be secure and have a ring number attached, they are not permitted at the ringside.
16. All grooming to be done in grooming area and placed in bins. Social distancing must be observed.
17. Toilet facilities will be provided by SCCA not the usual blocks on the Showground and will be kept inspected by the SCCA.
18. Food and refreshments will be provided by a limited amount of catering stands and the main caterers.
19. The SCCA Vet will be in attendance for our use.
20. First Aid services will be in attendance through the whole of the show.
